Product News:

***** California Endive Farm is experiencing labor shortages, they do not have enough harvesters to keep up with demand. Both white and red endive are limited.**

***** Avocados: CA season is winding down faster than expected. Mexican availability has improved but we will stick with CA crop until the end. We are expecting another week of consistent CA supply this week but next week will be hit and miss. We have already switched to Mexican Organic 48 count, price is high at the season's start.**

Apples: Organic Heirloom apple varieties in stock from Solana Gold! Gala, Jonathan, King Of Thomkins, Macintosh, Rhode island Greening & Winter Banana Apples, more varieties to follow. Conventional apple update: WA grown Red Delicious, Fuji, Honey Crisp & Pink Lady varieties are in stock. We are also using the last of the controlled atmosphere Washington state grown Granny Smith Apples until the new crops start in late September.

Blueberries: Pacific Northwest volume has decreased due to hot temperatures and low pack counts and fruit is showing quality issues including shriveling and small size berries. Peru and Argentina are in their first pick and expected to arrive this week, but delays are expected at the ports due to congestion and labor shortage.

Brussels Sprouts: Cabrillo Farms in HMB supply has picked up and market has also dropped this week. 4x5 half cut Brussels Sprout supplies are improving but price remains on the high side. Organic Brussels Sprouts are in stock from Lakeside Organics.

Figs: Black Mission supply is tight and expensive; pack count has dropped off due to quality (over ripe) caused by hot temperatures. Season will last until October.

French Beans: Trimmed 5x2lb pack French Beans supply is still very tight, shipment from Guatemala came in poor quality and Mexican supply is not enough to cover shorts. We are bringing in 10 lb loose pack from Mexico, but this item is also limited.

Squash: Comanche Creek's Toy Box Squash supplies continue with a new fall planting. Limited this week are straight packed Green Zucchini, Sunburst Squash & Gold Zucchini. New crop Organic Butternut & Delicata Squash are in stock from Coke Farm. New this week: Organic Mini Butternut Squash from Miller Farm. These squashes are about 8 ounces a piece and a perfect plate vegetable. Cases are 10 lb.

Stone fruit: Frog Hollow Peaches, Nectarines & Emerald Beauty Pluots are expected to be done for the season in about 2 weeks. Tulare County conventional stone fruit will end about the same time as well.
