Product News:

*****GARLIC SHORTAGE:** Domestic garlic market continues to be very active as Chinese product has stopped coming in due to port and transportation issues. Chinese product is over half the US market so domestic growers need to slow things down to manage supply. Spice World has caught up with peeled product so we are getting more supply in from them. There may be some relief in November, but until then it is likely to get worse. This is part of a global supply chain issue.

****SEASONAL TRANSITION:** The local Salinas season is approaching the end. Transition to Arizona is expected by second week of November. We are starting to see limited supplies and increased pricing on Arugula, Baby Kales, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Romaine Hearts and Iceberg Lettuce.

BLUE LAKE BEANS: Conventional Blue Lake Beans have limited availability until new crop in late October. We are filling in with organic.

BROCCOLI CROWNS AND FLORETS: Limited from all growing areas. Most of the limited supply is going to processors which is depleting the available supply. Prices are continuing to rise.

CABBAGE: Green, Red, Napa and Savoy Cabbage in stock, coming from Modesto, however green cabbage is getting tight and expensive due to bug issues in all growing areas.

HEIRLOOM TOMATOES: Organic Heirloom tomatoes are coming in unripe and taking several days to ripen. Local season is coming to an end and San Diego/MX supplies are limited and unripe as well. We are trying out Valdivia Heirloom tomatoes out of Carlsbad to start the week.

LETTUCES: Salinas Valley grown Artisan Mix, Green Leaf, Red Leaf, Baby Iceberg, Butter Lettuce, Iceberg, and Sweet Gem Lettuce supplies are mostly steady but Romaine Heart supplies have tightened and prices up again this week. Coke Farms Organic baby mix heads are limited this week. Organic Little Gem supplies are steady from either Coke Farm or Lakeside Organics. We have organic Red Little Gem lettuce in stock.

ORANGES: CA Valencia supply is very tight, nearing the end of the season, about 2 more weeks. 113 size is very limited and expensive. Navel orange season is expected to start the early November.

MUSHROOMS CULTIVATED: Several varieties are tight or very limited. Shiitakes medium and large are limited due to low yield from poor quality compost; Oyster mushrooms are also limited and Portobello mushrooms are limited due to sizing which is running smaller than usual. Medium White and Button Mushrooms, including sliced white mushroom supply, are all tight, same issue with poor quality composting which slowed down production. On a better note, all of the Gourmet Mushrooms organic varieties have steady supplies; Organic Alba and Brown Clamshell, Chefs Sampler & Trumpet Royale are all available, as well as Organic Hen of the Woods. Nebrodini is available by Pre Order.

SQUASH BLOSSOMS: Squash Blossoms are nearing the end of the season and are hit and miss, we recommend removing from your menu.
