Product News:

APPLES: New in from Solana Gold, organic Fuji and Rome Beauty apples! From OZ Farm, organic Jonagold apples are in stock. Oz Farm continues with Shinseiki Asian Pears, Belle De Boskoop, Caville Blanc, Cinnamon Spice, and Roxbury Russet. Ashmead's Kernel & Spitzenberg apples are gapping this week. New crop Washington grown Red Delicious, Fuji, Gala, Granny Smith, Honey Crisp & Pink Lady varieties are in stock.

BROCCOLI: All supplies have tightened and prices are up due to limited supplies. Conventional and organic Broccoli Crowns, Broccoli Romanesco, Sweet Baby Broccoli, & Organic Broccoli Di Ciccio are affected. 4x3 Broccoli Florettes are also limited and price is higher due to very high demand.

CORN: Local CA grown White & Yellow Corn supplies have ended from Brentwood. We are expecting some Riverside County grown White Corn on Tuesday. Organic Bi colored Corn is expected from the Bakersfield area on Wednesday via Coke farm, but may be hit and miss. Yellow corn is not available from any sources.

GREENS: Locally grown conventional Braising Mix, Baby Red Chard, Mizuna, Baby Mustards & Tat Soi will all be available starting this week. Grown in Hollister. Organic Chards & Lacinato Kale supplies are steady from either Comanche Creek, Coke Farm or Lakeside Organics. Organic Red Russian Kale is in stock from Comanche Creek. The Salinas Valley grown Wild Arugula, Baby Lacinato, Spinach & Spring Mix supplies are all steady as well.

GEM LETTUCE: Both Coke Farms & Lakeside Organics Little Gem supplies are very limited and subject to gapping. We are filling in with conventional Sweet Gem to start the week. County Line Farms will begin their winter program in early November including Little Gem varieties. We'll have more information soon on County Line's winter greens harvest schedule.

ORANGES: CA Valencia supply is very tight, season expected to end in 2 weeks. 113 size is very limited and expensive. Navel orange season is expected to start the end of October and word is that volume will be good on 88 and 113 size. Early Mandarins have very light set due to heat and expected to start harvest mid-November.

KENNEBEC: New crop Kennebec potatoes are starting now from Malin, Oregon. Chipperbec potatoes are limited; only available is still old crop from Bakersfield.
