Product News:

******MUSHROOM** supplies continue to be a sourcing problem. Very limited supplies on Hen of the Woods, Brown, Medium, Button, Shimeji and Oyster mushrooms. The limited supply is due to a series of issues, from low yields to supply chain hold up at the ports. More specific information is below.

Apples: Local apple season is winding down, with the heirloom varieties limited to stock on hand or done. Oz Farm Jonagolds are limited to stock on hand, these are the last apples of the season from Oz. We do have org Arkansas Black apples still in stock from Cuyama Orchards in Arvin, CA. Organic Fuji are in stock from Coke Farms. Washington State grown conventional Red Delicious, Fuji, Gala, Granny Smith, Honey Crisp & Pink Lady varieties are in stock.

Broccoli: Organic Broccoli Crowns supplies have improved and we have plenty in stock. They are also a value compared to the current conventionally grown Broccoli Crowns. Broccoli Romanesco, Sweet Baby Broccoli, Organic Broccoli Di Ciccio & Broccoli Spigarello supplies are steady to start the week. All but the Organic De Ciccio will move to the Arizona growing region for the winter months. 4x3 Broccoli Florettes supplies are now coming from the Central Coast for the winter months.

Grapefruit: Supply remains hit and miss on CA grown new crop Rio Red variety grown in Riverside County, we also are carrying organic 40 count to cover shorts. Texas grapefruit is expected to start in a few weeks, but due to the frost in Texas last winter, they are expecting a limited crop this year.

Grapes: Quality for California grapes has dropped off since they are all from cold storage now. The last 2 deliveries were rejected due to quality issue. Peruvian grapes will start showing up around end of December.

Greens: Suprema Farm's locally grown Baby Red Chard & Tat Soi are in stock to start the week. Baby Red Mustard has been discontinued as we have County Lines Red Frill in stock. Comanche Creek's Organic Braising Mix & Red Russian Kale are both in stock with steady supplies. County Line's Organic Chards, Collards, Lacinato Kale, Rocola & Red Frill Mustard supplies are ramping up for the season with twice a week delivery. The Salinas Valley grown wild Arugula, Baby Lacinato, Spinach & Spring Mix supplies are all steady this week but the growing area will transition to the Yuma Arizona area the week after Thanksgiving.

Melons: All CA grown Melons are finished for the season. MX grown Cantaloupe, Honeydew & seedless Watermelon supplies are in stock this week. Prices are on the high side but steady to start the week.

Cultivated Mushrooms: As we have been reporting, mushroom supply continues to be a problem. Organic Hen of the Woods supply is very tight on 6# bulk and retail pack. Brown Shimeji supply remains tight due to slow port release. Oyster mushroom supply remains limited from both CA and Canada, Organic is very tight now too. Organic Alba and Brown Clamshell, Chefs Sampler & Trumpet Royale all have limited supply due to low yield and heavy demand. Portobello supply has improved from CA and Canada, also Portobellini supply is steady. Supply on Brown mushrooms remain tight from our local grower in Santa Clara and also from Canada. Locally grown Medium and Button white mushroom supply has improved this week. Sliced white (3/16" cut) mushroom also has better supply and sliced brown (3/16" cut) available by 2-day pre order both local grown. Small, Medium and Large Shiitake Mushrooms supply is steady from CA. Organic Nebrodini is available by Pre Order.

Persimmons: Both conventional Fuyu and Haichiya are on hand season expected to run till mid-December. Comanche Creek's Organic Wonderful variety Fuyu & Haichiya Persimmons have ended for the season and the organic Fuyus are limited to stock on hand.
