>>>WEATHER AND TRANSPORTATION issues in Southern California and Arizona are affecting supplies from those areas. Most crops are very tight and some are showing damage from the recent rain and cold weather. Transportation has also been limited due to lack of drivers at the trucking companies. Especially tight are lettuces, particularly iceberg, green and red leaf and romaine. Slow growth due to cold temperatures is affecting broccoli, cauliflower, cabbages, and zucchini.

>>>TRANSPORTATION WAS ALSO AN ISSUE in the Pacific Northwest last week due to heavy snow and flooding. All shipments of apples, pears, onions and potatoes have been delayed, however we are expecting deliveries early this week.

Grapes: Supply is very limited and expensive. CA season is at the tail end and, while product is still available, we are seeing quality issues. Peruvian grapes are expected to start this week, but price will be very high.

Mushrooms: Overall the situation is improving! Supplies on Shimeji, Shiitake, Oyster, Portobello, Portobellini, locally grown Medium and Button Mushrooms and Sliced Mushrooms have all improved. Brown mushrooms are still limited. Organic – Gourmet Mushrooms farm will have steady supply on Organic Alba, Brown Clamshell, Chefs Sampler & Trumpet Royale and Hen of the Woods this week. We have a steady supply of conventional Maitake from China pack size is 24x150g. Wild – Fresh Hedgehog and Black Trumpet mushrooms are coming from WA/OR, also limited Fresh Orchard morels from Fresno.

Oranges: Recent rain have slowed down production of Navel Oranges, harvests have been delayed and there will be shortage this week on Navel 113 ct and 88 ct. We are expecting some weather damage to these crops. Cara Cara and Blood oranges have a steady supply from Tulare County. Bergamot orange is available now grown in Fresno but they are limited and expensive.

Strawberries: Santa Maria and Oxnard growing area were wiped out by the recent rain and Mexico is having labor issues due to holiday schedule. Trucks are also delayed at the border. Expect quality to be an issue for the most part this week. New variety Pine strawberries are available grown in Oxnard.
