Product News:

****** Cucumbers, Squashes, Eggplant and Bell Peppers are all seeing higher prices and delays caused by lack of transportation out of Nogales. There has also been a freeze in Florida which is causing the east coast to pull from the Nogales and west coast supply. The last spike of COVID is also greatly affecting labor in the field and packing houses which has created shortages of supplies.**

Fennel: Fennel supplies have tightened and prices are very high this week. Supplies are not expected to improve thru Feb. We are using 18ct, 24ct and 30ct to fill orders. Organic 12ct Fennel is back in stock this week.

Greens: Comanche Creek's Organic Red Russian Kale & Braising Mix are both in stock. County Line's Rocola, Organic Chards, Lacinato Kale, Red Frill Mustard & Spigarello supplies are steady. Yuma grown Wild Arugulas, Baby Lacinato, Spinach & Spring Mix supplies are all limited & prices are up all due to cold weather & higher transportation cost.

Lettuces: County Line's Organic Little Gems will be gapping starting later this week for about two weeks. We are looking for another source, but we may have to sub conventional Sweet Gems. Butter Lettuce, Green Leaf, Green Leaf Singles, Red Leaf, Iceberg & Romaine supplies from Yuma, Arizona are improving. Also Butter, Green Leaf, Red Leaf & Romaine Lettuce prices have dropped this week. Artisan Mix, Sweet Gem, Baby Iceberg, Petite & Jumbo Romaine Heart supplies are all steady to start the week. Organic 12ct Iceberg Lettuce & 12x3 Romaine Hearts are also in stock. County Line's BMX, Super Baby, Lollo Rosa & Baby Red Romaine supplies are steady this week. We are also stocking Oku Farms hydroponic butter lettuce, a local item from Pescadero and Pete's Living Butter Lettuce is in stock from Santa Barbara County, now in a 12ct bulk back as well as the clamshells!

Peppers: Organic Green & Red Bell Peppers have transitioned from local crops to MX grown & are very expensive. We are only stocking limited amounts of Green this week.

Roots: Quality of Chinese Ginger has improved and we are stocking it again, but will continue to monitor quality. Ginger has been challenged by quality and port issues from all sources, including China, Peru and Brazil. Galangal is in stock from Hawaii; Turmeric from both Fiji. Stocking Daikon out of Fresno County. Jicama in stock from Mexico

Squash: Zucchini and Yellow Straightneck Squashes are coming up through Nogales. Quality has been good but production has been limited because of cooler weather, and prices are elevated. This is expected to continue through February. Baby Sunburst and Zucchini are available by 2-day pre-order all product of MX. Conventional Butternut is now coming from Mexico. Chayote squash also available, we are keeping a few cases on hand product of MX. Acorn, Kabocha and Spaghetti are all new crop from MX. Organic Butternut supplies are steady from Coke Farm. Organic Mini Butternut is in stock from Comanche Creek. Organic Carnival Squash is in stock from Riverdog Farm. And we have a limited amount of Organic Delicata from Mexico and Honeynut Squash from Comanche Creek.
