# Fall Seasonal Items



# September, October, November

Fall seasonal fruits include apples, pears, persimmons, pomegranates, and quince. Around the end of October, the first hint of citrus season begins.

Vegetable highlights include artichokes/cardoons, the brassicas, broccolis, brussel sprouts, cauliflowers, celery root, fennel, leeks, and winter squash.

Apples: Most heirloom varieties are short cropping (around 2-3 weeks), and are not good storage candidates. Gravensteins herald the beginning of apple season in mid August as the harvest begins. Commercial crops are gathered now and placed in a controlled atmosphere storage to help through the winter months. Cold temperatures, ill timed heat waves, and storms can all affect the outcome of an apple season.

Artichokes: The summer heat drastically reduces the bloom of artichoke flowers, as the plant reacts by shutting down to conserve energy. While artichoke season peaks in spring, there's often a flush of supply in fall after the summer heat settles. Cardoons return in fall as well.

Avocados: The California-grown avocado crop continues to decline as fewer trees are farmed due to climate change, drought, and fires from previous years.

Berries: Blackberries, blueberries, and raspberries are being sourced from the Pacific Northwest and Mexico. In previous years, locally grown raspberries hang on into late October. We generally source strawberries year round from California, with New Zealand, Chile, Florida, or Mexico to cover if needed. Because soft berries do not travel well, cranberries and huckleberries are the best choice of berries during these months.







# Fall Seasonal Items

<u>Citrus</u>: Rio Star Grapefruit is a great choice to brighten your fall palates. Fairchild Tangerines, Buddha Hands, and Makrut (Kaffir) Limes are potential early fall arrivals. Citrus season does not fully get started until late November when Satsuma Mandarins, Blood Oranges, and Meyer Lemons gear up. Valencia Oranges end around this time, and we transition to Navel Oranges until late spring. Finger Limes continue throughout the fall season.

<u>Fennel</u>: Fennel is at its peak around this time of year, both full sized and baby. Fennel Pollen is also a great addition to the fall season.

Greens: Hearty greens thrive in cooler, autumn weather. Chard, Dandelion Greens, Escarole, Frisee, Collard Greens, Mustard Greens, and Kale are prominently featured around this time of year. Smaller leaved options include Braising Mix, Baby Mizuna, Red Mustard Greens, and Tatsoi. County Line Harvest is continuing with their popular Baby Head Lettuces in Thermal, California, along with their other specialty greens. There is a return of Organic Mixed Chicories and single pack varieties in October, including Castlefranco, Tardivo and Treviso. Soft lettuces like Spring Mix and larger leaf lettuces suffer as cool weather hits. Please note that sourcing from southern growing regions requires a two-day trip after harvest, which adversely affects quality and shelf life.

Herbs: Local Basil winds down and we shift to Baja California for a conventional variety around this time. We should have Mexico-grown Organic Cilantro and Italian Parsely supply through the winter months. Tender herbs such as Chives, Chervil, and Tarragon are challenged by the cold season. The hardier herbs such as Oregano, Marjoram, Rosemary, Thyme and Sage still come from small local farmers.

Mushrooms: Wild Mushroom supplies may be limited due to rainy weather.

Persimmons: Both commercially available varieties such as Fuyu and Hachiya come into season around mid to late October. Both finish before Christmas, sometimes in early December. Occasionally, we hit a vein of "chocolate variety" persimmons, which have intriguing coloring and flavor.

Roots: Fall is the prime season for root crops. Beets, Carrots, Parsnips, Turnips, Sunchokes, and Salsify are abundant at this time. The Black Spanish and Watermelon radishes are especially striking on plates. Purple Daikon and Purple Ninja are also available, along with Easter Egg and French Breakfast radishes.

Thanksgiving: Green Beans tend to be more chewy around this time of year. Better options for your menus include seasonal favorites like Broccoli, Broccolini, Broccoli Di Cicco, Cauliflower, Brussels Sprouts, Hard Squash, and Yams.
